Nasima Razmyar (born 13 September, 1984, Kabul) is the Deputy Mayor of Helsinki, responsible for Culture and Leisure (including youth and sports). Deputy Mayor Razmyar serves as the chairperson of the Culture and Leisure Committee and has been a member of the City Council since 2012. She represents the Social Democratic Party.

Ms. Razmyar was elected to the Finnish Parliament in 2015. She left the parliament in June 2017 in order to take the position of Deputy Mayor of the City of Helsinki.

Nasima Razmyar holds a Bachelor of Humanities degree in Community Pedagogy from HUMAK University of Applied Sciences in Civic Activities and Youth Work training programme (2013). In 2010 Razmyar was named the refugee woman of the year.
