

New Leaders Forum 2019: Call to Action

Over the years, the sports movement has published several declarations, recommendations and policies globally and in Europe. **Now, it is time for action.** The New Leaders Forum and its participants call the European National Olympic Committees, the European Sport Movement - men and women together - to **act** in advancing gender equality.

The New Leaders Forum participants are calling:

1. The European Olympic Committees (EOC):

- To advance gender equality in line with the IOC Gender Equality Review Project through the EOC Gender Equality Strategy, which was approved by the EOC at the General Assembly 2019.
- To encourage NOCs to nominate female candidates in the next election of the Executive Committee.
- To communicate the best practises and information related to gender equality through the EOC media channels.

2. The National Olympic Committees in Europe (NOCs):

- To set national goals and an action plan on equality by 2020, based on the IOC Gender Equality Review Project and EOC Gender Equality Strategy.
- To use the existing declarations, recommendations and policies as a source of inspiration to develop an action plan.
- To report progress and success to the EOC Gender Equality Commission.
