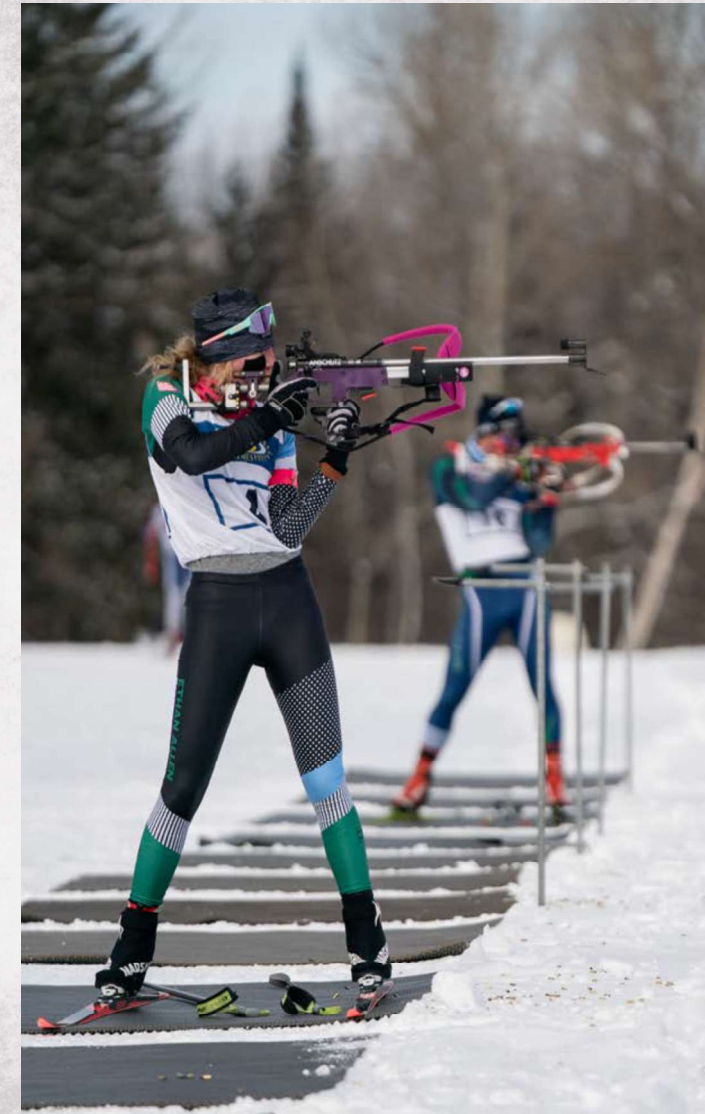

Climate

- Lake Placid can be quite cold during the winter months (December – March)
 - The city of Lake Placid in January has an average low of 6°F (-15°C) and high of 24°F (-4°C) however, these temperatures can drop as low as -25°F (-32°C).
 - Lake Placid averages 12 inches (30 cm) of snow every January
- ~ Please keep this information in mind when packing. These low temperatures can often be made worse by high winds and cloud cover, the Lake Placid region can often have a wind chill of well below 0°F (-18°C).

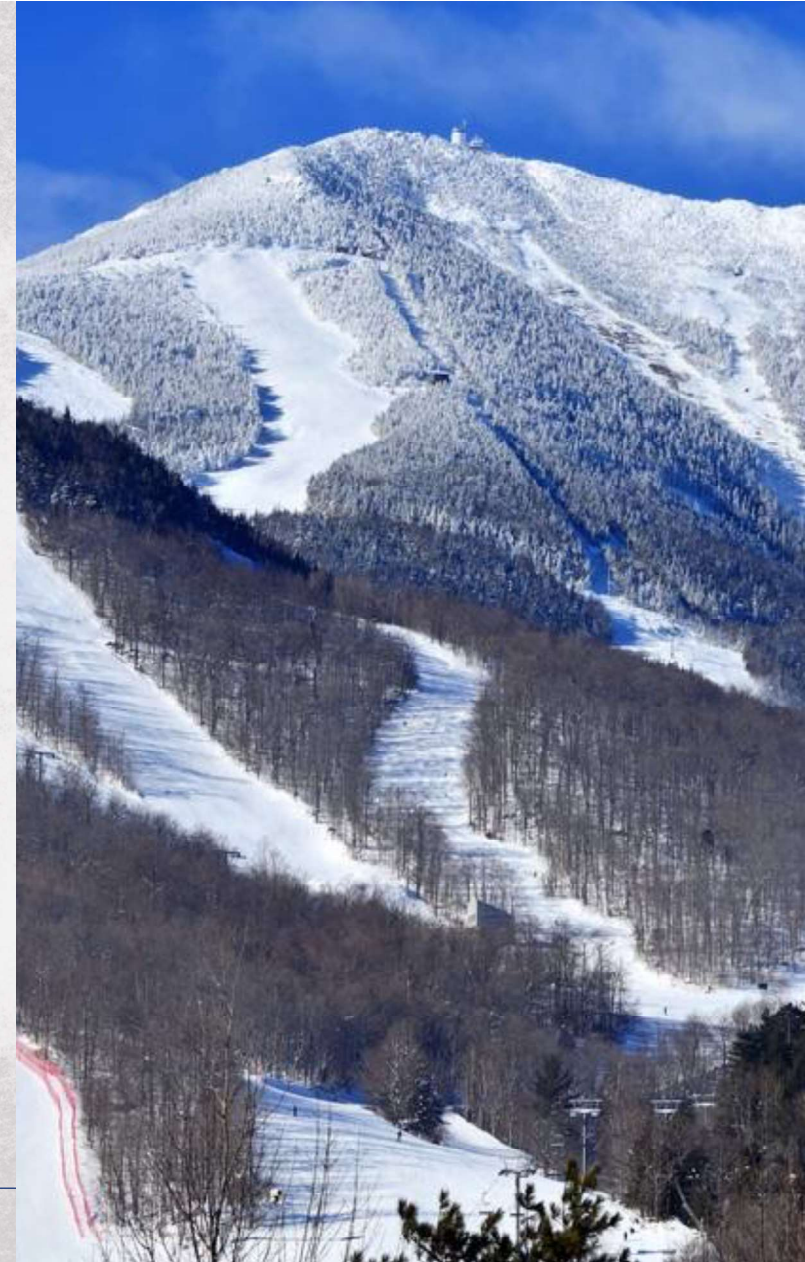

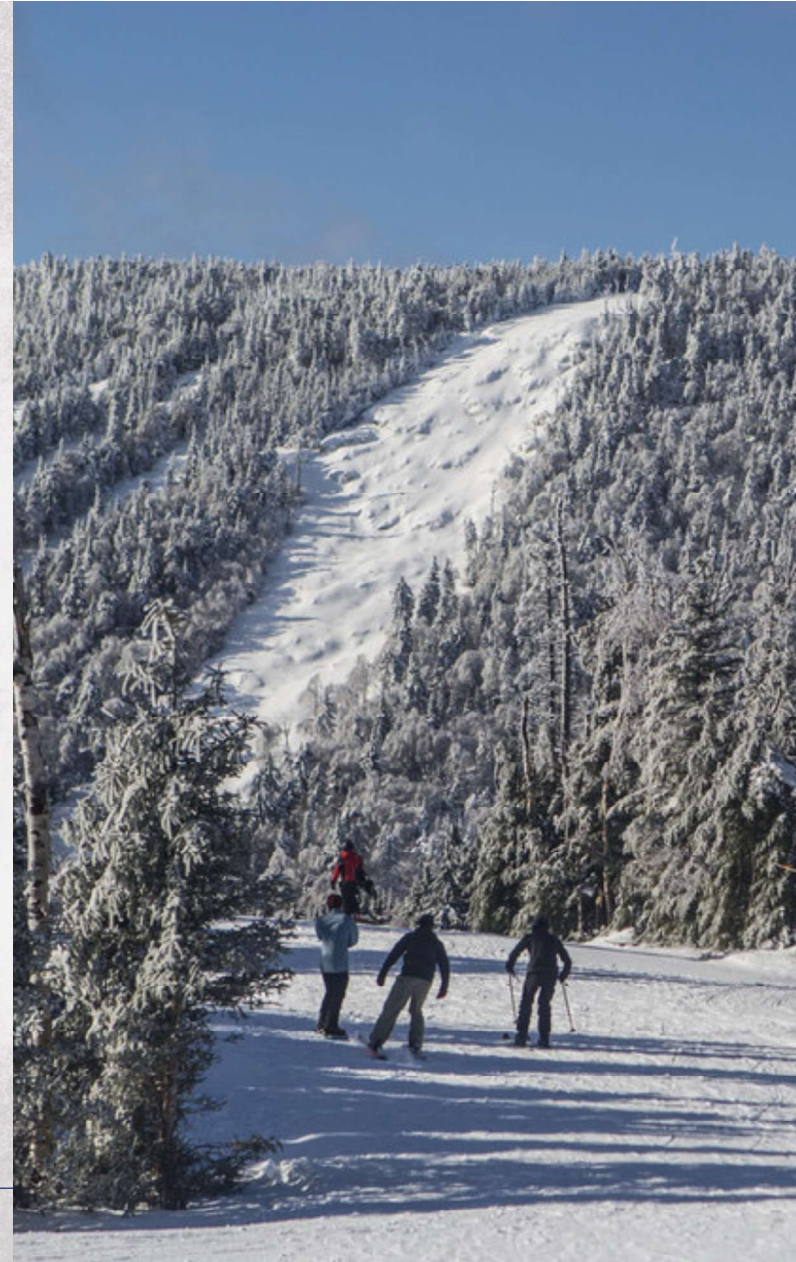

OVERVIEW

- All Villages have in-house food service operators experienced with feeding large groups of people
- Villages are permitted and licensed with the NYS Department of Health; a regulatory agency that oversees all food service operations. The Department of Health conducts regular inspections of licensed premises to certify that all operators are operating within regulations.
- Culinary staff are well trained in providing a variety of cuisines that well meet FISU expectations

MENU

- Menu development is in progress.
- Have received initial proposals from most Villages & are now reviewing to create a comprehensive meal plan
- All Delegations will have a similar culinary experience

ON VENUE MEALS

- In progress of being negotiated with existing venue operations.
- Services will be aligned with competition schedule.
- For venues without existing food service operators, i.e. Curling Venue, options are being explored

EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

Process for Emergency Services at each Village and Venue:

1. There will be on site Medical Teams (including a Physician) at each Village and Venue, and an on-site Ambulance.
2. Persons can call 911, or report to Medical Services area. For all other Emergency Services (hotels, restaurants, etc):
3. Persons should call 911, and 911 operator should proceed with normal operating procedures for dispatch of local ambulance.

DOPING CONTROL

- Partnering with USADA for all doping control needs
- USADA will bring Doping Control Officers (12)
- We will provide volunteer chaperones
- Samples collected by USADA daily, and either shipped to Salt Lake City or driven to Montreal
- Testing these processes at our test events

Doping control stations are at:

- All Venues
- All Villages (Village Central 1, Paul Smiths, Village West 1, Knowles Hall and Village South 1 Great Escape
- Main Medical Center, Lake Placid

COVID MITIGATION STRATEGY

The requirements for entry into the United States are as follows*:

- All non-citizen travelers **MUST** be fully vaccinated if travel by plane (with few exceptions)
 - Fully vaccinated means 2 weeks from: A single dose vaccine accepted by the US Government (Janssen/J&J) or a 2-dose series accepted by the US Government (Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Covishield, BIBP/Sinopharm, Sinovac)
 - The Sputnik vaccine is not currently recognized by the US Government or the World Health Organization, individuals who have only received this vaccine will not be permitted entry into the United States
- Testing prior to arrival
 - ALL travelers to the US will need to show proof of negative COVID-19 test result taken within 1 day of your flight.
- Quarantine/isolation Requirements upon arrival to the United States
 - If fully vaccinated, there is no quarantine or isolation requirement. Monitor for symptoms of COVID 19, and test if symptomatic.
 - We are planning to test all delegations on arrival, subject to change based on COVID prevalence world-wide.
- Testing During trip
 - This plan is being developed, but current projections would be PCR testing of all delegations weekly
- If the situation requires additional costs such as isolation or testing, these must be covered by the respective client group.
- Report ALL confirmed cases to the Essex County Dept of Health 1-888-270-7249
- FISU Medical Team and COVID crisis team will also be notified.

***Information is based on current restrictions and is subject to change as the Games draw closer according to local, state, and federal policies**

COVID MITIGATION STRATEGY

(Cont.)

- **Reporting of suspected/confirmed cases**

- Any client who develops symptoms must immediately inform the OC Medical Services FA, who will inform the respective authorities, as necessary.
- The OC Medical Services FA shall inform FISU immediately of any suspicious case. FISU will analyze the situation together with the respective local authority and OC Medical Services FA and will decide of the next steps to be taken such as:
 - Additional testing
 - Isolation of the contaminated person
 - Tracking of contact cases, Isolation of the full delegation/team/accommodation site
 - Other option at discretion of FISU

- **If entering through Montreal International Airport (YUL)**

- The U.S. and Canada have different COVID-19 policies
- If you enter through Canada, you may be subject to different rules regarding quarantine, vaccination and masking
- It is up to the Delegations to be aware of these rules and plan accordingly
